



# Dune Management- Proposed Works

## Piha Beach

The dunes in front of the Piha Surf Life Saving Club currently block the view of the 'Lion Rock rip' from the surf club control room. This creates a risk to public safety.

In order to mitigate this risk, it is proposed to re-shape the dune to lower the crest height by approximately two metres. This would allow unobstructed visibility of the water from the control room. The sand removed is proposed to be redistributed within the Piha Beach system, and the dune replanted with native dune species.

The approximate area of dune to be reshaped is highlighted in red in the above image.

A resource consent will be required for these works. The application will be submitted in April, with the intention to undertake the physical works in winter 2017.
